



ALL APPRENTICES NEED TO SCHEDULE THEIR CLASS EVERY SEMESTER - SCAN THE QR CODE

What is needed, when registered through an approved apprenticeship, to apply for an exam through the State Plumbing Board:

- **Indentured Apprentice:** The applicant must be currently enrolled in an approved apprenticeship program through the Louisiana Workforce Commission and registered as an apprentice through the State Plumbing Board
- **Residential:** have performed 3,000 hours of manual labor of plumbing under the direct, constant, on-the-job supervision of a journeyman or master plumber licensed by the board.
- **Journeyman:** have performed 7,000 hours of manual labor of plumbing under the direct, constant, on-the-job supervision of a journeyman or master plumber licensed by the board.
- **Natural Gas Fitter:** performed 3,000 hours of manual labor of plumbing under the direct, constant, on-the-job supervision of a journeyman or master natural gas fitter licensed by the board.

OPTION 1**

Must have application turned into APA before start of class to receive an exam date from the SPBLA for March 7th or after

OPTION 2**

This class is for any level of experience apprentice that is not taking an exam this semester

OPTION 3**

Must have application turned into APA before start of class to receive an exam date from the SPBLA for May 23rd or after

April 10th, 11th, 24th, 25th, May 8th, 9th, 22nd, & 23rd

This class is for any level of experience apprentice that is not taking an exam this semester
